Visiting Garden Chairperson

The Club President shall appoint the Visiting Garden Chairperson. The chair has the option of selecting other members to participate on the committee.

Term: 2 year

- The purpose of the Visiting Garden Chairman is to arrange for opportunities for enjoyment, education, and social gatherings through visiting gardens locally, nationally and internationally.
- The Chair of Visiting Gardens is responsible to:
 - 1. Facilitate club member visits to the gardens of other club members.
 - 2. Consider options wherein garden visits are combined with social gatherings
 - 3. Serve as a communication link between KMGC, the Zone XI Visiting Gardens Chairman and GCA.
 - 4. Act as a resource for members who wish to visit other Garden Club of America gardens throughout the United States.
 - 5. Disseminate Garden Club of America information about its organized garden tours and travel opportunities to KMGC members.
 - 6. Attend monthly board meetings as necessary.

The Visiting Gardens Chair should remain current by:

- •Attending any meeting arranged by national committee representatives in the Zone
- •Reading information about the national committee on the committee page of the GCA website.
